2010 ALTAMONTE SUMMER CAMP

Altamonte Sports & Programs offers a supervised recreation eight-week summer camp for children ages six to twelve from 9:00am until 4:00pm, Monday through Friday with drop off and pick up times being offered from 7:00am until 6:00pm. The program begins on June 14 with the last day being August 6. Daily activities include organized sports & games, swimming, arts & crafts, movies and optional field trips. Many other additional programs (**which can be found on pages ten & eleven**) will be available for summer camp participants to include in their weekly activities at an additional fee. This camp is offered at Westmonte Recreation Center in Altamonte Springs and is available to both city and non-city residents. Additional information regarding fees, drop off & pick-up, field trips, additional programs and lunches are included in this brochure. PARENT ORIENTATION

PARENTS: Prior to the camp beginning, you will have an opportunity to have all of your questions answered in person and review the camp brochure with Program Manager, Ryan Thompson. Parent Orientation will be held at Westmonte Recreation Center on Thursday, June 10 at 6:00pm. We encourage all parents to attend.

STAFF

Altamonte Sports & Programs summer camp employees meet City of Altamonte Springs screening standards, which include a level two national background screen. Each employee is selected for their enthusiasm, character, and experience in working with and around children. Our employees have various backgrounds including recreation, education, business, arts, and entertainment. Our counselor-to-camper ratio of supervision is one to sixteen.

Our camp is designed to provide a safe and fun environment for all campers, to promote emotional and physical health through creative participation, to provide opportunity for success, recognition, and acceptance by others, to encourage desirable traits such as sportsmanship, cooperation, self-discipline, respect for authority, and to learn a variety of basic skills in areas such as sports, arts, and other enrichment activities.

We encourage all parents to be involved. Please feel free to talk with our summer camp staff about your child's experiences.

REGISTRATION

Altamonte Sports & Programs will allow for Altamonte Springs residents (**must reside within the city limits of Altamonte Springs**) to register on-line beginning Monday, April 12, 8:00am. You can access our on-line registration page by visiting www.altamontesports.org and clicking on the City Summer Camp link. Please follow the provided instructions once you access our on-line registration page to sign in and register your child. On-line registration will continue until the program is full (**400 children**).

Altamonte Sports & Programs will also offer an "in-person" registration day for Altamonte Springs residents (**must reside within the city limits of Altamonte Springs**) on Saturday, May 15 (**in conjunction with Westmonte Recreation Center's annual "Day in the Park"**) from 9:00am until 12:00noon at Westmonte Recreation Center. Proof of residency (**lease, utility bill, bank statement etc.**) and a valid photo ID must be presented at the time of registration.

The non-refundable fee for Altamonte Springs residents is \$300.00 per child (**cash, check, money order, Visa and MasterCard are accepted**). Families with two children will be discounted at \$280.00 per child and families with three or more children will be discounted at \$260.00 per child. If space is still available on June 7, 8:00am Altamonte Springs residents will also have the option to pay \$50.00 per child per week. **NOTE:** Space is not guaranteed for the entire summer. This option is for families whose child will only be attending a portion of the eight-week summer camp. All weekly payments must be made at least one week in advance (**Cash, Money Order, Visa and MasterCard are accepted; NO CHECKS!**).

If space is still available on June 1, 8:00am, we will open on-line registration to non-city residents and continue registration until the program is full. The non-refundable fee for non-city residents is \$400.00 per child (**cash, check, money order, Visa and MasterCard are accepted**). If space is still available on June 7, 8:00am non-city residents will also have the option to pay \$60.00 per child per week. **NOTE:** Space is not guaranteed for the entire summer. This option is for families whose child will only be attending a portion of the eight-week summer camp. All weekly payments must be made at least one week in advance (**Cash, Money Order, Visa and MasterCard are accepted; NO CHECKS!**). Discounts are not available to non-city residents.

Campers are divided into age groups by gender (**6-7 Girls, 6-7 Boys, 8-9 Girls, 8-9 Boys, 10-12 Girls, and 10-12 Boys**). In order to ensure the safety of the campers and the quality of the camp, participation is limited to 400 children. **NOTE:** Individual group sizes may vary.

PARENTS IMPORTANT: YOUR ON-LINE REGISTRATION WILL NOT BE COMPLETE UNTIL YOU TURN IN THE CHILD INFORMATION SHEET (WHICH CAN BE FOUND ON THE INSIDE OF THE FRONT COVER) TO WESTMONTE RECREATION CENTER NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, JUNE 11, 5:00PM. IF WE DO NOT RECEIVE YOUR CHILD INFORMATION SHEET BY THIS DATE YOUR CHILD WILL LOSE THEIR SPOT AND FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.

DROP OFF / PICK-UP POLICY

Campers can be dropped off as early as 7:00am and picked up absolutely no later than 6:00pm. There is full supervision during these times. Due to the summer camp and other activities throughout Westmonte Recreation Center, there are hundreds of children being dropped off and picked up during these times. Please follow these guidelines to ensure the safety of all the children:

DROP OFF:

All parents are required to park their vehicle in the parking lot and walk their child to the front tent located in the playground area to **sign them in**. Under no circumstances should any vehicles stop at the crosswalk by the playground or under the overhang to drop off a child.

PICK-UP:

All parents are required to park their vehicle in the parking lot and walk up to the front tent located in the playground area to **sign their child out**. Be prepared to show a valid photo ID. Under no circumstances will a child be released to vehicles parked at the crosswalk or under the overhang.

EASTMONTE RECREATION CENTER PICK-UP & DROP OFF (SATELLITE SITE):

MORNINGS: To have your child transported from Eastmonte Recreation Center to the summer camp at Westmonte Recreation Center, your child must be at Eastmonte Recreation Center no earlier than 7:00am and no later than 8:30am on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays. On Thursdays, due to our full day field trips, your child must be at Eastmonte Recreation Center no later than 8:00am. If your child misses the bus, it will be the parent's responsibility to find transportation to Westmonte Recreation Center.

AFTERNOONS: Campers will be transported back to Eastmonte Recreation Center by 5:30pm. All campers must be picked up by 6:00pm. An electronic authorization (**which can be done through your City of Altamonte Springs on-line account**) is required.

WALK/BIKE TO & FROM CAMP:

Campers who live near Westmonte Recreation Center are allowed to walk/bike by themselves to and from camp. An electronic authorization (**which can be done through your City of Altamonte Springs on-line account**) is required. **NOTE:** Please make a plan with your child so they know what to do in case of inclement weather.

Campers are allowed to arrive late and/or leave camp early. Please check-in at the front tent located in the playground area if you need to sign in or sign out your child at any time.

Field trips and/or additional programs will not be adjusted to accommodate a child's individual schedule.

LATE PICK-UP POLICY:

All campers must be picked up by 6:00pm. No exceptions! The following policy will be enforced if a camper is left after 6:00pm:

First Time - Verbal Warning

Second Time - Written Warning

Third Time - Monetary Late Pick-Up Fee to Cover Staff Overtime Costs

Our intent is to provide a safe environment for all children at Westmonte Recreation Center. Failure to adhere to the guidelines we have set forth may result in an additional monetary fee or possible suspension and/or dismissal from the summer camp.

FIELD TRIPS

Throughout the summer camp a number of optional field trips have been scheduled. To participate in these trips, additional fees and electronic authorizations are required. You may select any field trip you wish your child to participate in, or your child may participate in all field trips. Since transportation and group rates have been made in advance, field trip fees will not be refunded or credited. Also, passes to various attractions will not be accepted due to group rates. Field trip fees can be paid through your City of Altamonte Springs on-line account at any time. **NOTE:** On-line field trip registrations are only accepted up to the Thursday, 11:59pm prior to the week of the trip. You will also be able to register for field trips in person on Friday mornings from 7:00am until 9:00am at Westmonte Recreation Center for the following weeks trips only (**Cash, Money Order, Visa and MasterCard are accepted; NO CHECKS!**). **ABSOLUTELY NO FEES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 9:00AM!**

All campers going on field trips must wear their summer camp shirts on every field trip. This shirt will be received at the time of registration or if you registered on-line it will be received the first day of camp. If a camper going on a field trip comes to camp without a summer camp shirt, one will be given to the camper (**if available**) and the parent will be charged \$5.00. Extra shirts can also be purchased for \$5.00 (**extra shirts are limited**).

All field trips are fully supervised! However, on full day field trips, campers between the ages of ten to twelve are allowed to part in groups of four or more (**if you do not want your child to part from a counselor please notify the Field Trip Coordinator prior to the trip**).

All campers participating on Monday, Wednesday and Friday field trips will eat lunch prior to leaving as lunch is not provided on these field trip days. Lunch is included on Tuesday field trips. Lunch is not included in the field trip fee for Thursday. Due to our Thursday field trips being an all day event, we recommend a minimum of \$10.00 for lunch if your child plans on purchasing a lunch. Lunches can also be brought from home and taken on the Thursday field trip.

SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

POOL USAGE:

The swimming pool at Westmonte Recreation Center is not considered to be a regular feature of the summer camp; however, it may be available to campers whose parent gave permission through an electronic authorization **(which can be done through your City of Altamonte Springs on-line account)**. By granting your child permission to swim in the pool, you are acknowledging that you are confident that your child has the necessary skills for water activity. Campers may be without direct supervision from a camp counselor while using the pool; however, American Red Cross certified lifeguards will be on duty at all times. If at any time, our lifeguards witness a child who does not possess the necessary skills to use the pool, the child will be removed from the pool and the parent will be notified. **PLEASE NOTE:** There will be no swimming on the first day of camp.

Campers ages 6 & 7 may use the pool from 11:00am until 12:00noon Monday through Friday. During this hour the pool will be designated specifically for this age group and closed to the public. An electronic authorization **(which can be done through your City of Altamonte Springs on-line account)** is required. Campers who choose to swim will eat lunch at 12:00noon and return to their group activities at 1:00pm. If your child is scheduled to attend an afternoon field trip they will not have the opportunity to swim that day and will eat lunch at their scheduled time **(11:00am)** and prepare for their afternoon trip.

Campers ages 8 & 9 may use the pool from 12:00noon until 1:00pm Monday through Friday. During this hour the pool will be designated specifically for this age group and open to the public. An electronic authorization **(which can be done through your City of Altamonte Springs on-line account)** is required.

Campers ages 10, 11 & 12 may use the pool from 1:00pm until 4:00pm Monday through Friday. During these hours the pool will be designated specifically for this age group and open to the public. An electronic authorization **(which can be done through your City of Altamonte Springs on-line account)** is required.

Campers are allowed to bring a bag with their swim items **(swim suit, sunscreen, etc.)**. These bags can be stored inside our auditorium. Parents are asked to make sure all bags are clearly marked with their child's name. Campers are not allowed to bring any type of floatation devices, pool toys or goggles.

FIELD DAY:

On Friday, July 9, the summer camp will have a special "Field Day". On this day special activities have been arranged for all campers who choose to participate. Such activities include: use of the pool **(with an electronic authorization)**, special interactive games, moonwalks, lunch, movies and popcorn. In order for your child to participate, a fee of \$10.00 and an electronic authorization **(which can be done through your City of Altamonte Springs on-line account)** is required.

WEEKLY THEMES:

Each Friday we have a weekly theme contest to show camp spirit. Campers, please join in with good taste. Prizes will be awarded.

Week 1: Weird and Wacky Socks Day (WEAR THE STRANGEST COMBINATION OF SOCKS)

Week 2: Caribbean Day (BREAK OUT THE FLOWER SHIRTS AND GRASS SHIRTS)

Week 3: Patriotic Day (CELEBRATE THE FOURTH OF JULY BY WEARING OUR NATION'S COLORS)

Week 4: Backwards Day (WEAR YOUR CLOTHES BACKWARDS OR INSIDE OUT)

Week 5: Wild and Strange Hat Day (TRY ON THAT BONNET, TOP HAT, FARMER HAT OR COWBOY HAT)

Week 6: Favorite Team Sports Day (WEAR THE CLOTHES THAT SAY WHO YOU'RE ROOTING FOR)

Week 7: Clothes Clash Day (WEAR THE ODDEST CLOTHES COMBINATIONS THAT YOU CAN THINK OF)

Week 8: School Spirit Day (SHOW YOUR SCHOOL SPIRIT BY WEARING YOUR SCHOOL'S COLORS)

LUNCH & SNACKS

SNACK BREAKS:

All campers have the option to break for a snack twice daily. These times are at 10:00am and 2:00pm. Campers will be asked by their direct counselors if they would like to break for a snack at these specific times. Campers do not have to break for a snack since they are OPTIONAL. **NOTE:** Snack times only apply when children are in their regular group at Westmonte Recreation Center.

If you would like your child to participate in a snack break, they must bring snacks from home. Campers will not be allowed to purchase snacks during these times. Snacks can be stored in a small cooler and/or container inside our auditorium. Parents are asked to make sure all coolers and containers are clearly marked with their child's name. **PARENTS:** Please discuss with your child not to eat their entire lunch at the 10:00am snack time.

LUNCH BREAKS:

All campers will enjoy a one hour daily lunch break from 11:00am until 12:00noon (with the exception of campers ages 6 & 7 who participate in their optional daily swim from 11:00am until 12:00noon who will eat lunch from 12:00noon until 1:00pm). Campers who wish to bring a lunch from home will be able to store a small cooler and/or container inside our auditorium. Parents are asked to make sure all coolers and containers are clearly marked with their child's name. We also offer a lunch program for anyone who wishes to purchase lunch on site.

Campers who live close by are also allowed to go home for lunch. Those going home will be dismissed at 11:00am and should be back to camp by 12:00noon. An electronic authorization (which can be done through your City of Altamonte Springs on-line account) is required.

Parents who wish to eat lunch on site with their child must check-in at the front tent located in the playground area. Be prepared to show a photo ID.

LUNCH PROGRAM (CONCESSIONS BY LAWLESS SUBS):

Please visit *Lawless Subs* on registration day Saturday, May 15 from 9:00am until 12:00noon (Altamonte Springs residents only). If you registered on-line and/or not able to attend the registration on Saturday, May 15, you will be able to pay for the lunch program on any Monday between 7:00am and 9:00am at the front tent (located in the playground area), while camp is in session. All payments must be clearly marked in a sealed envelope. Only weekly and summer payments will be accepted. If your child is paying for the day they must keep the money themselves. **NOTE: THE LUNCH PROGRAM IS DESIGNED FOR CAMPERS ON SITE DURING THE LUNCH HOUR. THE LUNCH PROGRAM DOES NOT PROVIDE LUNCH WHILE ON FIELD TRIPS. LUNCHESES WILL NOT BE CREDITED DUE TO ABSENCES, FIELD TRIPS, ETC. DUE TO ALL LUNCHESES BEING PREPARED IN ADVANCE.**

- **Monday:** Pizza, Chips and a Drink
- **Tuesday:** Hot Dog, Chips and a Drink
- **Wednesday:** Sub (Ham & Cheese or Turkey & Cheese), Chips and a Drink

INCIDENTS, HEALTH & MEDICATION

INCIDENT REPORTS:

As all campers participate in a variety of activities daily (sports, games, swimming, etc.), they may receive minor cuts, scratches, scrapes, etc. while participating. Each counselor on our summer camp staff is certified through the American Red Cross in First Aid and CPR/AED and will administer proper treatment to all minor wounds when necessary.

If your child is involved in a minor or non-urgent incident (minor wound, disruptive behavior, etc.), a summer camp employee will fill out a Summer Camp Incident Report. This report will be given to the parent upon pick-up. Parents are asked to review the report and sign acknowledging they understand the contents of the report. Please feel free to speak with a summer camp employee if you have any questions about the report. **NOTE:** Talk with your child about notifying a counselor immediately about all incidents, no matter how minor.

If your child is involved in an incident that we feel you need to know about immediately (illness, medical situation or emergency, fighting, theft, etc.), you will be contacted immediately.

HEALTH:

If your child becomes ill while at camp, you will be contacted and asked to make arrangements to pick your child up as soon as possible. We do not have the facilities or supplies to care for your child if he/she becomes ill.

If your child is ill, they will need to stay home. Please do not bring your child to camp until they have fully recovered or are cleared by their doctor. **NOTE:** If your child comes to camp ill, we will not allow your child to sign in for the day. Please be respectful to all campers and staff by keeping your child home when he/she is ill.

The summer camp staff is not permitted to provide or apply campers with any kind of medication, this includes sunscreen. Please provide your child with the appropriate amount of sunscreen. We encourage you to apply sunscreen before your child arrives to camp each day. Please show your child how and when to reapply sunscreen.

If your child will be absent for any reason, please contact us by calling the Summer Camp phone line 407-571-8730.

MEDICATION:

If your child requires prescribed daily medication, please complete the section on the Child Info Sheet (**which can be found on the inside of the front cover**). If your child needs any assistance with their medication please speak with the Program Manager prior to the first day of camp so the appropriate arrangements can be made. Medication can be stored on site.

If your child has special needs (**medical, behavioral, nutritional**), please specify those needs on the Child Information Sheet (**which can be found on the inside of the front cover**). Feel free to discuss these needs with your child's direct counselor.

DISCIPLINE

DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR:

If at any time a child demonstrates disruptive behavior (**disrespectfulness, name calling, foul language, horseplay, poor sportsmanship, etc.**), the following actions will take place:

First Offense:

- Verbal warning from direct counselor

Second Offense:

- Time-out from group activities

Third Offense:

- Time-out with Playground Leader
- Summer Camp Incident Report (**parent signature required**)
- Parent Conference with Playground Leader

If after counseling with the parent the situation persists, your child will be suspended from the camp for one day. Any further disciplinary problems will result in dismissal from the Summer Camp. **NOTE: IN CASES WHERE A CHILD IS DISMISSED FROM THE SUMMER CAMP THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF FIELD TRIP FEES, ADDITIONAL PROGRAM FEES, LUNCH FEES OR REGISTRATION FEES.**

ZERO-TOLERANCE BEHAVIOR:

Disruptive behavior that is harmful to self or other campers and/or property of self, City and other campers will not be tolerated and the following actions will take place:

Fighting (physical contact regardless of who started it):

- Parent will be contacted immediately
- Time-out with Playground Leader until camper is picked up
- One day suspension from camp
- Repeat offense will result in dismissal from the Summer Camp

Theft or Destruction (personal, City or other camper's property):

- Parent will be contacted immediately
- Time-out with Playground Leader until camper is picked up
- One day suspension from camp
- Repeat offense will result in dismissal from the Summer Camp

We hope that we do not have to contact you about disciplinary behavior. Remember, you the parent play the biggest role in supporting your child's behavior. This helps keep our camp safe for all that are involved. We encourage you to talk with your child and our summer camp employees about behavioral problems if they are brought to your attention.

Please refrain from allowing children to bring the following items from home:

- Head Phones, IPods, Zunes, MP3 Players, etc.
- Radios, CD Players, Cassette Players, etc.
- Portable Game Systems
- Cards of any type
- Toys
- Jewelry
- Cell Phones, Pagers, etc. **(Exceptions are made in emergency situations; however, all campers must notify a counselor before use.)**

If a child is caught with any of these items at any time, the item will be taken away and will be kept at the front tent located in the playground area. The parent will be notified about the incident. The City of Altamonte Springs and its employees are not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen items.

We also recommend that campers do not bring large amounts of money to camp. Please only allow your child to bring the appropriate amount of money to cover their daily camp expenses. Again, we recommend that everything your child brings to camp is clearly marked with their name. If items are left behind, we will store these items in our lost and found bins. These bins will be located in the auditorium and on the pool deck. Please check the lost and found bins often as all items that have not been claimed by the end of camp will be donated to an organization of our choice.

ADDITIONAL PROGRAMS

This year we will be offering some unique additional programs that your child may be interested in attending. **(These additional programs must be registered for online)**. To participate in these trips, additional fees and electronic authorizations are required. These programs are offered at an additional fee to cover the cost of the program. All fees are non-refundable. **NOTE:** It is the camper's responsibility to attend these classes; however, we encourage you to speak with your child's direct counselor about their participation so the counselors are aware of their participation and can help create a plan to have your child regularly attend their additional programs.

Jr. RANGER PROGRAM:

Open to campers between the ages of 9 to 12. This program will take place at Lake Lotus Park with transportation provided by the Summer Camp. The program is designed to show your child how to explore, learn about and help protect the natural environment. Some of the topics are: Ecosystems, animal tracks/casting, reptiles and bat houses. This program will meet once a week for six weeks **(there will be no program during week one and week five)**. Classes will be held from 9:00am until 11:00am on Mondays. A minimum of fifteen participants must register to conduct the program. Space is limited to thirty participants. Cost: \$25.00. For more information please call Ryan Thompson at 407-571-8736.

BOXING PROGRAM:

Open to campers of all ages. This program takes place at the Westmonte Recreation Center boxing room and is instructed by *Central Florida School of Hard Knocks*. The program is designed to teach individuals the basics of boxing in a structured, fun and safe environment. This program will meet once a week for eight weeks. Classes will be held from 9:00am until 11:00am on Tuesdays. A minimum of fifteen participants must register to conduct the program. Cost: \$45.00. For more information please call Aldaberto Morales with *Central Florida School of Hard Knocks* at 407-844-0198.

CHEERLEADING PROGRAM:

Open to campers of all ages. This program will take place at Lake Brantley South with transportation provided by the Summer Camp and is instructed by *American Spirit Elite*. All participants will receive a t-shirt, learn proper conditioning and stretching. They will also learn a series of cheers, jumps and dances. Campers will be split into two groups: Beginner and Intermediate/Advanced

- Beginner: This level is for campers with little or no experience in cheerleading.
- Intermediate/Advanced: This level is for campers who have participated in cheerleading lessons before or have cheerleading experience from cheerleading in a league.

Classes will meet once a week for eight weeks on Wednesday mornings from 9:00am until 11:00am. A minimum of fifteen participants must register to conduct the program. Space is limited to thirty participants. Cost: \$45.00. For more information please call Kim Wheeler with *American Spirit Elite* at 407-325-7069.

GYMNASTICS PROGRAM:

Open to campers of all ages. This program will take place at Lake Brantley South with transportation provided by the Summer Camp and is instructed by *Junglenastics*. Classes will meet once a week for eight weeks on Thursday mornings from 9:00am until 11:00am. The program stresses fun, fitness and technique and is open to campers of all abilities. All participants will receive a t-shirt. A minimum of fifteen participants must register to conduct the program. Space is limited to thirty participants. Cost: \$50.00. For more information please call Nichole Williams with *Junglenastics* at 407-766-3240.

SCIENCE PROGRAM:

Open to campers of all ages. This program will take place at Eastmonte Recreation Center with transportation provided by the Summer Camp and is instructed by *Mad Science*. The mission of this program is to spark imaginative learning in children through educational, entertaining and exciting activities that instill a clearer understanding of what science is really about and how it affects the world around us. Participants will attain a deeper knowledge of science through classes like Slime Time, Glow Show, Spy Academy, Space Travel and Dry Ice Capades. Each class participant will receive a *Mad Science* branded kit as part of the class materials.
